He was granted PROMOS and DAAD scholarships, and together with media artist Lukas Rehm he won the national award "Federal Prize for Art Students" with their documentary work "Default".

After finishing his master's degree, he moved to Sofia, Bulgaria, where his son was born, for several years. He now lives with his family in Vienna and continues to shoot for art and independent film projects, as well as developing his own artistic projects.
